.... AND ALL THAT RAZZ-MA-TAZZ!



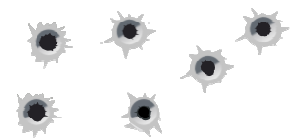
Calling all Gangsters and Gun Molls! Step back in time- back to the 1920's as a matter of fact! Prohibition is the law of the land- but the gangsters think they can make their own rules!. Learn how Prohibition started in the United States and was promoted by Canada- and the impact it had on the nation.

First stop on this journey back in time? Chicago. Visit the site of the St. Valentine's Day Massacre, see where Al Capone

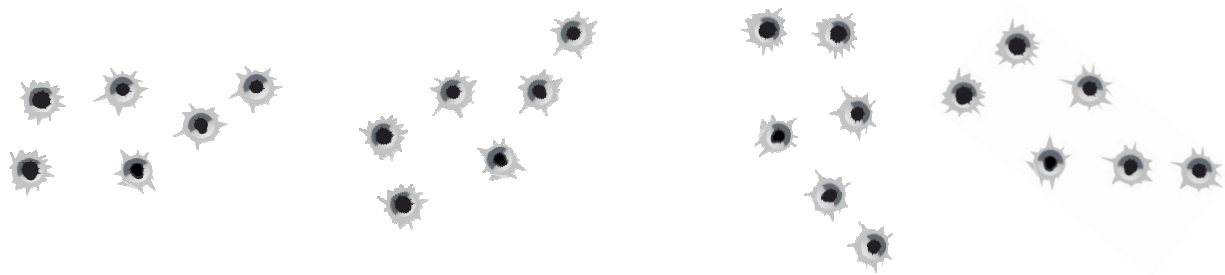
roamed and Dillinger died. Enjoy yourself as we cruise the city in search of the old hoodlum haunts, gambling dens and sites of gangland shootouts! A dinner at a speak-easy- with hooch included- and an overnight stay at Chicago South Loop Hotel ends the evening.

After breakfast a stop at the John Dillinger museum allows you to see how the G-men tracked and found the gangsters. Get fingerprinted, step into a cell or try on a bullet proof vest while there. At Jackson state Prison you find out what happened to the gangsters that the lawmen captured. A tour and lunch (don't worry- it is more than bread and water!) shows what life behind bars was like.

Tonight we overnight in Windsor, Canada at the beautiful Caesar's Casino. Try your hands at the slots or the tables- imagine you are spending the proceeds from some of the bootleg booze you have been selling along the way.

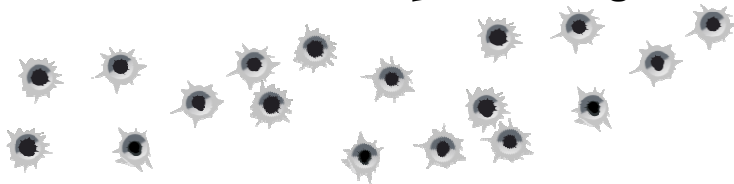


After breakfast the next day we explore how Canada contributed to the Prohibition. Costumed characters join us as we travel throughout the city- learning about the Temperance movement and the Rum Runners. Lunch and entertainment at a speak easy is included and a tasting and tour at Canadian Club is a sweet treat!! Freshen up at the hotel before we head to Cooper's Hawk Winery for a tasting, tour and a delightful private dinner. Try your luck at gambling back at the hotel before you retire for the evening.
